6. Hospitality and Commercial Cookery courses include mandatory work-based placement. Faculty requires 100 hours of work-based placement.
7. The number of holiday weeks may vary depending on the intake date.
8. For students (ACEI) students: Fee term: Subject: Award: is required for the full coverage of an enrolment fee. This must be applied for and approved after the enrolment.
9. For offshore students, payment of a deposit of two terms of the first course tuition fee is the enrolment fee.
10. The enrolment fee should be paid in full prior to the commencement of the course.
11. International students may be eligible for a grant.
12. Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC) fees are not included in the above fees. OSHC is a compulsory requirement in accordance with the requirements of your student visa.
